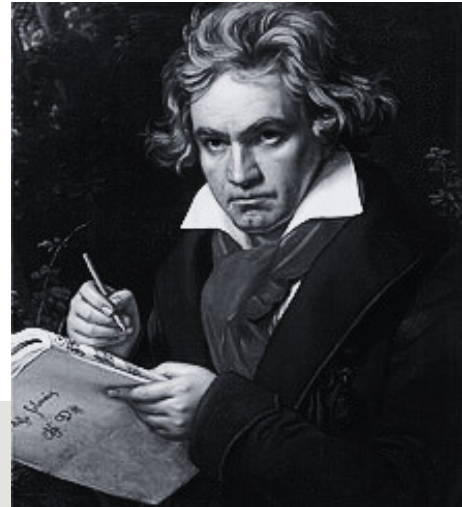

Quatuor Zaïde can also propose a selection of quartets and folk in 1 or 3 concerts.

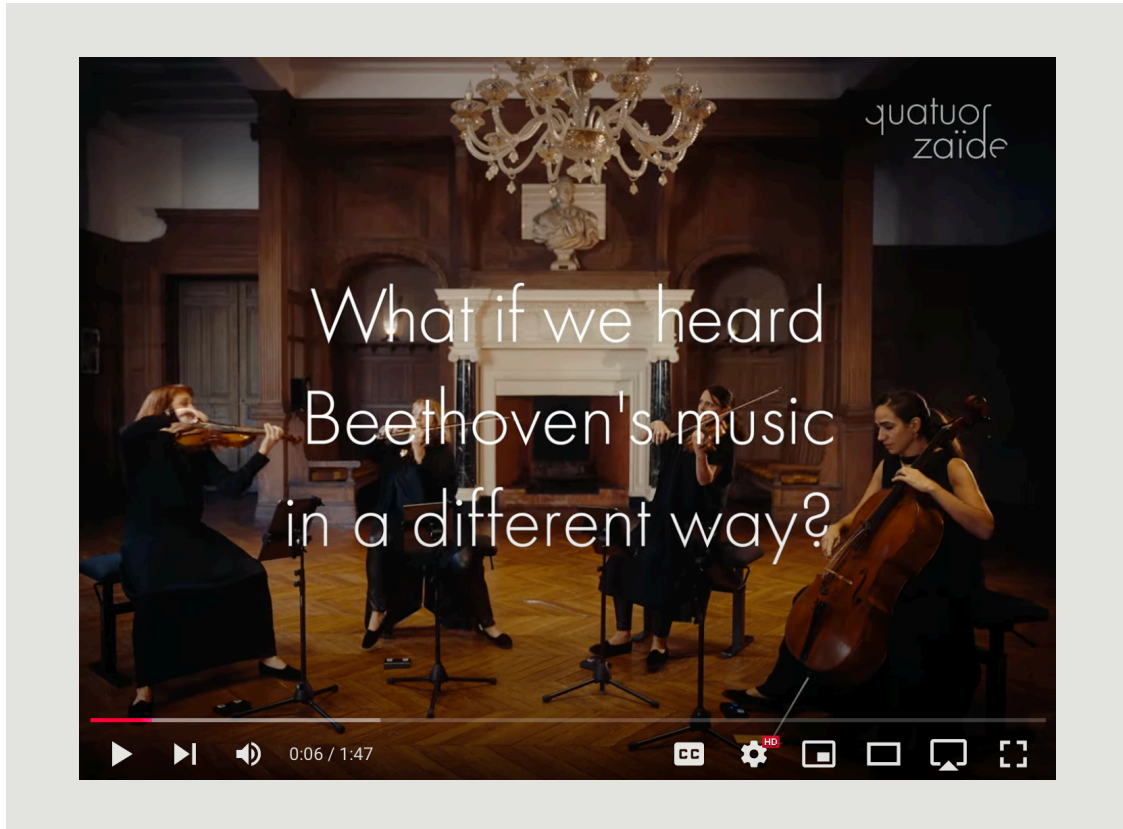


Through traditional music, the Zaïde quartet explores a new way of looking at the integral of Beethoven quartets.

Created in 2009, the Zaïde quartet has established itself on the international scene as one of the rare quartet made up entirely of women. The numerous prizes from prestigious international competitions obtained between 2010 and 2012, in Bordeaux, Vienna and Beijing, established it as one of the essential chamber music ensembles in the musical landscape classic.

He is today recognized for his high standards and his continued exploration of sound spectrum of the quartet.
